Are Bill Cosby and many others are causing massive outrage with these scandals?

With the news of many celebrities being claimed to have done immoral acts, the public is acting in separate ways. Some are defending these celebrities while some are angry towards them and wish they pay if they have actually committed these scandals.

Bill Cosby, loved by so many- to the extent where he was known as America's Dad, had his reputation destroyed when it was heard that he had done something disgusting. Many people were outraged-disgusted knowing this person they trusted had been a bad man the whole time and that they bought his nice guy act.

He was sentenced to 3 to 10 years of jail time for sexually assaulting Andrea Constand at his home 14 years ago. A decade later, dozens of women came forward to say Bill Cosby drugged and sexually assaulted them over the years. This proceeded to kick start the #MeToo movement. Cosby was convicted of three counts of aggravated indecent assault for drugging and assaulting Constand.

He was ordered to pay a fine of \$25,000 plus other costs for things such as prosecution. Cosby begin his crimes during 2004. He gave Constand some pills, and then sexual assaulted her which she reported in 2005. However, prosecutors proceeded to decline the charges. The case would be settled a year later.

Other celebrities have been assumed to have done similar things and cause similar outrage as Cosby. The most recent example of this was Robert Sylvester Kelly, more commonly known




as R.Kelly. He has been caught up in an awful situation. The singer/producer was in big trouble in 2002 when he was caught in a sex tape with a 14 year old girl. He has also been in multiple relationships- 16 to be exact. His biggest known immoral act was the Aaliyah scandal. He had married her when she was only 15. He met Aaliyah Dana Haughton when she was 12 years old. The marriage was annulled a year later. Kelly was also accused of imprisoning women in a sex cult.

Chris Brown, another celebrity known to have messed up many times, had as-

O.J Simpson was accused of murdering his ex-wife in 1994, who was found dead- stabbed to death- outside her apartment in Los Angeles with a friend. He was the prime suspect for the case, but on June 17, police were notified when Simpson hid in the back of a sports vehicle with his friend A.C. Cowlings. This lead into a car chase, with law enforcement officers followed the vehicle at low speeds for more than an hour

Simpson was called to court on July 22, 1994, stating a plea of not being guilty, The Los Angeles district attorney's of-



saulted Robyn Rihanna Fenty, better known by her middle name Rihanna, in his car in 2009. The assaulted was described as him punching her numerous times while he put her in a headlock, restricting her breathing and causing her to start to lose consciousness. He verbally threatened to "beat the s***" out of her. He also threatened to kill her, according to the statement, also biting her ear and her fingers.

Brown has also been accused of rape in Paris, where he was then arrested for aggravated rape and drug violations but was later released without charges. The most recent incident of his was in July 2017, where he was arrested for reportedly punching a man who photographed him without his permission in April of the same year.

fice, led by Marcia Clark and Christopher Darden, emphasized the domestic violence that had occurred prior to and after the Simpsons' 1992 divorce as a motive for the murders. Simpson's team's defense was based largely on the grounds that evidence had been mishandled and that many members of the Los Angeles police department were racist, especially Mark Fuhrman, a detective who allegedly found a bloody leather glove at Simpson's home. They argued it couldn't be his due to the fact the glove was too small on his hand. But on October 3, Simpson was found not guilty of the murders of Nicole Brown Simpson and Ronald Goldman. In 1996, Simpson was sued by the victim's family and not even 4 months later he was found guilty of the murders despite the previous case, and payed the family \$33.3 million in damages.

Some interviews were taken in order to get some opinions on if celebrities should be held accountable for their mistakes. Shannon Ferrelli, the Social worker at Dr. An Wang Middle School, was asked some questions. she was asked if they didn't acknowledge their mistakes, and if it does affect people. She said, "... It would send a negative impact if they don't..." Another interview, with questions asked to Matthew Santy, Assistant Principal of the Dr. An Wang Middle School, was asked if the celebrities should be held accountable for it. He said, "... They are people, and anybody that makes a mistake should be held accountable...". The last interview was with the Guardian Counselor of the Dr. An Wang Middle School, Lyndsay Roy, was asked if it does it affect people. She said, ... I think so because a lot of people are involved by celebrities..."

Some of these people mentioned are facing jail time, while some are free, running around, but being called out by thousands everyday. Simpson has been released from jail, and seems to be living his life as happily as he can. Brown has recently been in the spotlight because of more of his mischievous and awful acts resurging. Cosby is still in jail, paying the time for the crimes he's committed. People are making sure that, if they commit these horrible acts, that they are getting the consequences than non-celebrities would receive. They want them to be able to repent for what horrid things they've done.

"Bill Cosby took my beautiful, healthy young spirit and crushed it. He robbed me of my health and vitality, my open nature, and my trust in myself and others. ...We may never know the full extent of his double life as a sexual predator but his decades-long reign of terror as a serial rapist is over." - Andrea Constand, in her victim impact statement.

Other people think that violent video games can increase social skills, an the New York Post again states "And, if you fear that buying games for your juvenile relative will turn him into a solitary delinquent, John Velez, a researcher at Texas Tech University, allays those worries. In 2015, according to Vice, he found that



war games enhance social skills. Velez has concluded that team-play games of this ilk - such as Halo and TimeSplitters - led participants to treat each other, whether teammates or opponents, with surprisingly high degrees of decency." Many people blame computer games for people having social illness, but at least 230 other academics in the same field who disagree with this statement.

Now second off many people are saying that violent video games can affect people in a very bad way, evidence to support this is "Violent video games show kids how to express themselves physically, in a violent way." What this is saying is if kids play violent video games, they might learn that, rather than solving a problem by talking it out, they will fight out the problem instead. The topic of school starting times has been discussed over the past couple of years, but little did society know it was going to get bigger. Recently, this topic has stirred the pot even more than before. It's now attracting doctors, local residents/citizens, and even the students, themselves. All over the U.S,

people are voicing their opinions on this specific topic. It's gotten so much attention, that even sources such as CNN and sleep foundation are addressing it as well. It's now almost impossible to walk out out your house and not either engage in this topic, or even hear about it. Studies show that the average teen falls asleep at 11:00 p.m on a school night. A current poll done at the Dr. An Wang middle school in Lowell, Massachusetts shows that an average of 46.43% of the students get about 6-9 hours of sleep, 46.43% get about 6-3 of sleep, and 7.14% get 3 hours or less. This specific middle school starts at 8:00 a.m This isn't always the case, though. Soldiers who have just joined the military get a salary of \$19,660 for under 2 years of experience.

In the military, there are bonuses such as \$5,000 for heavy construction, \$15,000 for enlistment bonus, and \$12,000 for cooking. The longer you are in the military the more money you get. With a range of \$50-\$450 monthly, plus the \$1,638 you already get.

As you train and become more experienced with the military, you slowly climb up the ranks. From the lowest being the second lieutenant, to a gen-

40's and they would get \$4,000 monthly for the rest of their lives. This equates to an accumulative pay of \$480,000, \$960,000, \$1.4 million in 10, 20, and 30 years. \$480,000 being when you are in your 50's, \$960,000 being in your 60's, and \$1.4 million in your 70's.

Ever since technology integrated into education, students and families have struggled to get access to technology for school use. There's no specific reason, but the overall agreed one is that the families have a low income.

The first thing Sue Gannon, the cook manager at the Wang Middle School, said when asked the question, 'do you think student should be supplied with a computer by the city?' was, "No... All kids have cell phones... if you own a home, you own a phone. There's no way you don't own or have access to a phone." Her opinions matched the research on a study on teens. "A new study by the Pew Research Center finds that 78 percent of Americans aged 12 to 17 have cell phones. And it says that three-fourths of teens access to Internet using mobile devices such as smartphones or tablets" And that study was done in 2013. Imagine how the numbers have climbed.

Others obviously have different opinions on the subject. Katie Mahoney, an english teacher at the Wang middle school said: "The way the world is moving, a lot of things are being done online in schools. Testing is done online now." Schools have done multiple fundraisers to get technology in the classrooms, such as smart boards, laptops and iPads. Google Classroom is an online classroom, as per the name. It allows teachers to grade, assign, view assignments and help students virtually.

Two years or so ago, on May 31st, 2016, the book "The Math Myth: And Other STEM Delusions" by Andrew Hacker rose principles that some might consider absurd upon first glance; that advanced mathematics isn't something that should be required for high schoolers or high schools in general. This, of course gained quite a bit of traction, even its release covered by the New York Times. This had led quite a few people to question if it is necessary after all. Advanced mathematics, of course, has its pros and cons. This article will list what exactly these are, and people's opinion on it in general.

To start off, one of the many pros of Algebra II and advanced maths is that it's quite necessary for the current system of college, seeing as many fields re-

quire math. These go from physics, to music, to psychology and so forth. In the conclusion Dress Code infractions should be considered minor, and discipline should not involve removing a child from their learning environment. School staff should also avoid shaming (in the form of "Dress Code Violation" shirts or measuring straps). Dress codes need to have a clear, fair-minded motivation, and they need to be enforced consistently without regard to race or gender. Like any other tool in a school system, a school's dressing policy needs to teach the correct lessons, not the incorrect ones. Dress codes are a perfect example of an educational policy that puts compliance before learning; pressures and demands before support; a topdown bureaucratic solution created by adults at the expense of the time and effort it takes to really listen to and learn from students.







Super Bowl 2019 Parade Affecting Students From Education



Why are designers watches costing 1,000s of dollars?


